Department of Health and Human Services announces additional distributions from the Provider Relief Fund to eligible Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program providers

This communication applies to the Medicaid programs for Simply Healthcare Plans, Inc. (Simply) and Clear Health Alliance (CHA) as well as the Florida Healthy Kids (FHK) program for Simply.

On June 9, 2020, the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), through the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), announced additional distributions from the **Provider Relief Fund** to eligible Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) providers that participate in state Medicaid and CHIP programs. HHS is also announcing an additional distribution of Provider Relief Funds to safety net hospitals.

- HHS expects to distribute approximately \$15 billion to eligible providers that participate in state
 Medicaid and CHIP programs and have not received a payment from the Provider Relief Fund General
 Distribution. On June 10, 2020, HHS launched an enhanced provider relief fund portal that will allow
 eligible Medicaid and CHIP providers to report their annual patient revenue, which is used as a factor
 in determining their Provider Relief Fund payment. More information about eligibility and the

- HHS also announced the distribution of \$10 billion in Provider Relief Funds to safety net hospitals that serve the most vulnerable citizens. The safety net distribution is expected to occur the week of June 8, 2020. This payment is going to hospitals that serve a disproportionate number of Medicaid patients or provide large amounts of uncompensated care.
